

## TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

### ONCOCARE National Junior Squash Championships 2025

#### Tournament Dates + Times

- 18 to 22 March 2025 (Tuesday – Saturday)
- 9am – 7pm daily

#### Tournament Venue

- ActiveSG Kallang Squash Centre  
(8 Stadium Boulevard, 397804)

#### Categories and Cut-Off Dates

- Boys' and Girls' Under-9
- Boys' and Girls' Under-11
- Boys' and Girls' Under-13
- Boys' and Girls' Under-15
- Boys' and Girls' Under-17
- Boys' and Girls' Under-19

Cut off dates for **ALL** events is [22 March 2025](#).

#### Draw Size

- Depending on demand, draw sizes are limited to 16 or 32 entries per category.
- Singapore Squash reserves the right to change the draw size if it is deemed necessary.

#### Entry Registration, Eligibility & Closing Date

- It is open to **Singaporeans only**. Singapore Squash reserves the right to ask for proof of this.
- Participants can play in up to two (2) events, subject to availability. In the event there is a surplus of entries, priority will be given to players playing within their highest age group. For eg. Between a 14 and 16 year old in the U17 category, priority will be given to the latter.
- Entries must be received with payment via online entry form by [Monday 24 February 2025 \(2359 Singapore Time\)](#).
- **Late entries** will not be accepted, unless at the prerogative of Singapore Squash.

### Entry Fee payment

- **SGD 40** Entry fee per category (includes tournament t-shirt)
- All entries to be done via **Tournament Software** and payment made with **PayPal** at the point of registration at the Tournament Page:

### Withdrawals and Entries Adjustment/Removal

- The withdrawal deadline is **Wednesday 26 February 2025 (2359 Singapore time)** and must be done in Tournament Software. All withdrawals within the deadline will have registration fees refunded.
- All withdrawals after the deadline must be accompanied by a medical certificate or supporting documentation. They will be deemed as late withdrawals and unless approved by Singapore Squash, they are deemed unacceptable and may be subjected to further disciplinary actions. These include but not limited to suspension from future SSRA and/or AJSS events. No refunds will be given for late withdrawals.
- Singapore Squash will endeavour to accommodate all entries but reserves the right to reject any entries (even if submitted on time) to better suit the draw. For clarity, a draw is best in multiples of four (4) and eight (8) if there are an odd few out of that in a particular category, Singapore Squash will have the right to remove participants on a **last-in-first-out (LIFO)** basis to make a more complete draw.
- Any player accepted into the main draw who fails to appear for the tournament without notifying Singapore Squash of his/her withdrawal will be blacklisted from other Singapore Squash and/or AJSS events for a no-show. Any appeal must be submitted in writing.
- No matches are to be rescheduled unless with permission from the Tournament Director. **Rescheduling of final position matches for prizes will not be entertained.**
- **The tournament requires the full commitment of a player to complete all his/her matches. Players who are uncertain of their schedule are encouraged not to sign up to avoid any disruptions to the fixtures.**

### Code of Conduct

- All individuals attending and/or participating in the event, conducted under Singapore Squash auspices e.g. player, parent, official, coach, connected with a participating player or team, or other involved person, are to comply with the SSRA Code of Conduct (<https://www.sgsquash.com/policies/>).
- Coaches, parents, guardians, and spectators must not interfere with the officiating referee's decision while the match is in progress. SSRA has the right to remove any such offenders from the venue.
- The Match Referee has the right to penalise any player should their coach, parent, guardian, or supporter commit any offence in attempting to influence the outcome of a match.
- Players, coaches, parents, guardians, or anyone who interferes with the smooth running of the event will be asked to leave the tournament venue and may be subject to further disciplinary action.

### Seedings and Draw

- A category must have a minimum of 8 players to be opened. In the event the minimum number of players is not met; the organizer may exercise the option to combine with a higher category or remove the category.
- The seeding will be carried out solely by Singapore Squash based on knowledge of players, and recent and past tournament results, which is deemed appropriate.
- Special consideration will be given to the following:
  - Players who have no ranking but with past achievements.
  - New players with no ranking or results.
  - Players who were away overseas and have no recent local results.
- Draws will be done via the Tournament Software platform.

### Scoring & Format

- All main draw matches will be played to the best of 5 games. However, Singapore Squash reserves the right to decide the format of play depending on entries and court availability.
- 11 points – PAR (Point-A-Rally) following the WSF Rules of World Singles Game.
- The **19-inch** tin height will be used for all the categories.
- **Circuit/Monrad Format will be used, whereby all players continue to play, win or lose through to a final finishing position.** However, final changes/decisions will be made by Singapore Squash depending on the number of entries and court time available.
- Check in **40 minutes** before your scheduled match time. Match timing is an indication only. Matches will be played on a **FOLLOW-ON-BASIS. Postponement of matches will not be entertained.**
- Players will be required to referee matches if called upon.
- A walkover will be awarded against players who do not show up **10 minutes** after their name is called; subsequent matches will be forfeited and subjected to a ban (up to 1 year from all Singapore Squash organized/supported events) unless a valid medical certificate is produced and prior notice is given to the organizer.
- (check SJO text) – that players might be playing 2 matches a day per event.
- The Tournament will be run in accordance with the ASF/WSF Championship Regulations.

### Official Ball & Eye Wear

- Dunlop Double Yellow Dot Balls will be used during the Tournament.
- Eye-wear is mandatory for all participants. This includes any activity in the courts.

### Prize Money & Prizes

- Prize presentation will be held for the top eight winners of each category.
- Prize presentation for **all age groups will be held on Saturday, 22 March 2025 at approximately 3.30pm** after the Boys Under-19 final. **All prize winners must wear the tournament t-shirt.**
- Trophies will be awarded to top four of each category. Medals will be awarded for places 5-8, if there is a minimum of 16 participants in the draw.
- Cash prizes will also be awarded to the top three winners in the U17 and U19 categories. However, this is condition that there is a minimum of 16 participants in the draw. Singapore Squash reserves the right to alter the cash prizes structure in the event there are less than 16 participants in the draw. The breakdown of cash prizes is as follow:

Placing	U17	U19
1	\$200	\$400
2	\$100	\$200
3	\$50	\$100

- Cash prize winners are to proceed to the tournament control and provide bank details for payment of their prize monies. Winners who are not present for the prize-giving ceremony will have their cash and other prizes forfeited.

### Others

- The Organising Committee reserves the right to interpret or amend the rules and regulations of the tournament at any time. Notification of such changes will be communicated to players via a WhatsApp group or email. All participants are advised to check frequently for any announcements or changes to draws/schedules.
- While reasonable precautions will be taken, the Singapore Squash Rackets Association, its servants and its agents will not be responsible or in any way liable for any death, disability, personal injury, loss of property or any other loss howsoever arising from any cause whatsoever at any time during the course of this tournament.
- By agreeing to participate in this tournament, you are granting SSRA permission to use your images for promotional and publicity purposes.
